

Century Band Boosters  
Parent Meeting minutes  
May 16, 2023

- Jr class trip proposal
  - Some members of the Jr class came to talk about what they would like for a trip with the band for next year. They put in a lot of work researching options and costs to present to parents and Mr Dunlop.
  - There is a Veteran's Day parade on Friday of spring break that we have been invited to participate in (March 29, 2024)
  - They propose leaving Wed of spring break and staying 4 nights, returning Sunday 3/31.
  - Hotel costs that they found would be \$150-\$300/night per student
  - Activity ideas - Pearl Harbor, punch bowl cemetery, Polynesian cultural center, Hard Rock Cafe, hikes, beaches
  - They talked about lots of food options that they found
  - They estimate that airfare would be \$700-900 per person
  - Food ~\$160 per person
  - Total \$1200-1350 per person
  - This leaves out some things like the cost of buses. Mr Dunlop will put them into contact with some travel agents who can help them get a more accurate estimate of costs but this is a great start.
  - The parents present at the meeting were supportive of them continuing to look into details for this.

  - Patricia Bradley made a motion to vote for this group as a whole. Koda LaMadrid seconded. There were no objections.

- Victoria Trip

- We are asking for a medical form that is specific for this trip. This was recommended by the ferry workers to help our crossing the border go as smoothly as possible. It should be signed by all guardians. That was included in the email.
  - Students who are 15 and under will need a birth certificate and photo ID.
  - Students who are 16+ will need a passport.
  - If students are 16+ and their passport is late, come and talk to Mr Dunlop. It may be possible for them to cross with a school group with their birth certificate. It does say that it is an option on the ferry website but the workers there say that it is often complicated and slow. If they want to try and come with us that way, Mr Dunlop wants a parent to come along just in case there is a significant delay so that the whole group doesn't get stuck and miss the ferry..
  - School buses will take us to Port Angeles
  - We will be walking onto ferry
  - A charter bus will take everyone to the middle school where they are staying.
  - On the way back they will walk from middle school to ferry so they should keep that in mind when they are packing!
  - Charter buses will meet us in Port Angeles to take everyone back to Century
  - There are 2 other performances that are not on the itinerary because we don't have details yet. Mr Dunlop will let us know when he has them.
  - Students should bring a sack lunch for the way up.
- Fundraising
    - Everything is Awesome!
      - The students played at 950 doors and collected \$4840 in donations.
    - Auction - 6/2 - \$40/ticket
      - Accepting donations now!
      - Baskets need to be ready by the 24th
      - Christina is organizing a competition for the section and class with highest selling basket
      - Tickets will be up on the website asap
      - The auction will be at Century in the cafeteria
      - More details will be available soon.

      - We could use more parent help for future can drives
    - Nov 16 and March for pies next year
    - 4th of July fireworks stand will start June 29
  - There was a discussion about how to better communicate with incoming freshman parents

    - Copies were handed out and discussed.
    - Koda LaMadrid moved to approve it
    - Adreann Randle seconded it
    - The budget was approved by the group.

- Graduation
  - The band will be playing as one big group (all classes minus the seniors). More details will be sent out closer to the date.
  - Graduation is June 10 at 10 am. We should be finished around 12
  - There will be a bus to and from the stadium
- Camp Amp/Hillsboro Jazz Academy - July 10-21st
  - Mr Dunlop is hoping to get info out this week
  - It will not be going through parks and rec this year because they wanted to charge \$500+ and Mr Dunlop and Joe were struggling to agree with them about how it should be run.
  - We will be charging ~\$200 for each camp
  - Jazz camp in the morning
  - Rock camp in afternoon
  - Mr Dunlop has a \$5000 grant to help cover the costs
  - Joe Aloia will be in charge
  - It will be open to students going into 7-12 grade
  - They are still working out registration
