- Election for secretary
 - Ivan Halstead would like more information about the secretary job. Patricia will send him some and we can talk about details. For now, Joy Trimble nominated Patricia Bradley for the secretary position. Maria Crowell seconded it. There were no objections.
- Fundraising
 - Winter Showcase: This is happening March 11 at Liberty HS. We need lots of help. Percussion groups will perform in the morning, guard groups in the afternoon. Both will perform in the gym. There are a total of about 40 groups. Signups will go to the full band soon. Students can volunteer if not in one of the groups performing. They can get a fundraising point for working a shift. Students can also earn NHS or Key Club volunteer hours if they don't need more points but they can not get both volunteer hours and a fundraising point, they will need to choose. Students can be selling ads for the program to earn a point.
 - Corporate sponsorships: Please reach out to companies who may be willing to sponsor the showcase. Christina Saribay is leading an effort to find sponsors. She would like to set a goal of \$10,000. Please let us know if you know of a company that would be interested.
 - Jazz Auction: The jazz auction will happen around Mother's Day. We are waiting to hear back from the Elks Lodge about when they are available. If you would like to help with the auction, please let us know!
 - Can drive: Next Can Drive March 18th
 - Spring pies: We have been talking to Willamette Valley Pies about a date.
 - Mother's day flower sales: April 10-24.
 - Mr Dunlop is setting up an "It's a Small World" type fundraiser like we did last year. A tentative date is on the calendar for May 2. A new name/music is tbd.
- Winter percussion/guard
 - Guard looked great at the Tigard show. The coaches are doing a great job. Meeting at Indian Hills at 7:30 on Thursday.

- Update on trips
 - Passports! Please don't wait too long if your student needs a new passport or passport card to join us for the Victoria trip! You will need to make an appointment at the passport office to file the paperwork and times to get the passport after that are longer than usual right now.

- Victoria trip (5/19-22): We may need to ask families to pay a small fee for food for this trip. Everything, including buses and hotel rooms, is much more expensive than the last time that we planned these trips. Buses are more than twice the price as before Covid. The Victoria Day Parade is on a Monday. We will return on Monday after the parade.
 - San Francisco trip: We plan to leave Friday (3/24). The competition that they are performing in is at Foot Hills HS, Pleasanton, Ca. We have reservations for Alcatraz on Sunday. We will return Monday night ~8:00 pm. We plan to stay in a school on Friday night and a hotel near San Fran on Saturday night, but we are not sure which one yet. We will send out that information as soon as we have it.
- Jazz band
 - League Jazz Festival (2/9). The One O'Clock Jazz band won! Their scores qualified them for the state competition. Congratulations to them.
 - West Salem Jazz Festival (2/11). We did not stay for awards so we are not sure of the results yet. One parent stayed for part of the awards and learned that the small combo took 3rd place.
 - Jazz Night at Venetian (2/15). This is a fundraiser for the HillHi band. Tickets are \$15. Both jazz bands will play from 7:30~8:30. Call time will be 6:15. Liberty's jazz band starts playing at 7. We will return ~9:30, after the last band plays.
- Solo and ensemble (3/4): Every student in all of the band classes needs to perform a solo or ensemble for an assignment in class. There is also the district solo and ensemble festival at Mountainside HS. The deadline to register was last Saturday (2/11). Mr Dunlop will send the schedule for that once he gets it, probably next week. Mr Dunlop will schedule some recitals at school for those not going to Mountainside throughout the spring semester.
- Cluster concert (3/21): This will be in the gym with all of the feeder grade schools, Brown, and all of our bands. Mr Dunlop will try to keep it at 1 hr 15 minutes. The rehearsal on 3/20 is only for grade schools. Mr Dunlop will need a few high schoolers to help set up chairs.
