  - Shows on 3/19 and 4/2 - more details will be emailed out.
- CHOMP is up and running. Students are welcome to come and volunteer. Thursday nights until the concert on May 12.
- Open Board Positions
  - Fundraising
  - Secretary
  - Anyone may run for any board position if you would like. These 2 currently have no one running for them though. If anyone is interested, let us know. We are happy to send more information about the positions. Elections will be at the May parent meeting.
- Fundraising
  - Pie sales. The information will be ready to send out tomorrow. We want all sales to go through the website this time around. (<https://www.centuryband.org/shop>) You can turn in checks to the gray box with an order form if you don't want to pay through the website but please enter all orders there. This will allow Barb to look in one place to find all orders so that there is less chance of mistakes.
  - Dream dinners. We will have 5 different options for pre-packaged, ready to cook meals. You can choose 3 and order through a link that will be sent out. March 30 will be pick up day at 4:30 at Century. \$50 for a set of 3. The band will make \$10 for each order. Since this is a restaurant fundraiser, no points will be given for this one.

  - Hanging baskets. Al's mother day March 30-April 20. Delivery will be May 5&6. 2 different sizes (10 and 12 inch) \$30 and \$40 each.
  - HOPS concessions are asking now if we can provide staffing for next season. Students need to be 15 to work with a parent, 16 without. You earn \$12 per hour worked in your band account (no points or volunteer hours). There will be a survey sent out asking about how many shifts people will work. There is a Beavers game on April 5. They would love us to work it. Week day games usually start at 6:30-7:00 pm. They want leads to arrive 2 hours early, others 1.5 hours early. Everyone needs food handlers card and adults need an OLCC card. Both can be obtained online.

- The auction committee has been working on getting letters out and collecting donations. We are looking for great things to auction off in the live auction. If you know someone with a business who is willing to donate, email [auction@centuryband.org](mailto:auction@centuryband.org) with ideas. We are looking for 3 more people who can help with preparations for the auction. The next meeting will be right after this parent meeting. The auction is scheduled for May 14.
  - The band student officers are putting together a fundraiser. Students will go to houses and play "It's A Small World" in uniforms on 4/13. We will be asking for sponsors. Students will also take donations at the door. Donations taken at the door will be used to help a few kids who have worked hard this year but can't afford the trip. We will put together an email that students can send out asking for sponsors. We will set it up for people to make donations through the website too.
  - Fun run. Mr Dunlop has been meeting with people from the new Providence wellness center (Cornelius Pass and TV Highway). We are trying to get the date set up but we want to end at the wellness center at their grand opening and that date isn't set yet. Right now it is looking like it will be at the end of June or maybe in July. The run will be through some of the new roads in S. Hillsboro. Depending on the timing, we may do this instead of the fireworks stand this year.
- **Volunteers**
    - Starting on 3/28 HSD will require their new criminal background checks for all adult volunteers.
    - Parent chaperones are needed for some upcoming activities. An email will be sent out.
    - Camp Yamhill- 5 female & 5 male chaperones needed
- **Treasurers**
    - 38 kids have paid for CHOMP so far.
    - We made a total of \$6188 from the last 2 can drives.
    - Disney payments due. We need to start making payments for our hotel and flight reservations so please make sure you are up to date if you are going.
- **Calendar update sheet from Mr Dunlop (all updates are reflected on the current calendar)**
    - Arts assembly at Century (3/28 and 3/31). Parents can come watch.
    - Cluster concert has a new date (4/6).
    - Disney trip last payment new date (4/18).
    - Rose parade is happening the day after graduation. It is not required for seniors but they can join us.
    - Started cadet guard and drumline
    - CHOMP is going. High school students can come help

- Disney trip
  - All chaperones need to be fingerprinted (new HSD background check).
  - A bus will take us from the airport to the hotel in California.
  - Everyone will need to bring money for lunch for first day
  - Students will need to stay with their groups with their chaperone in the airport.
  - Students will get \$20 per day for food. They should bring more if they think this may not be enough. One parent shared that they know of an app for a card that the students could bring with them to Disney and parents can add money to use for food. I will look into details for this to share.
  - We haven't gotten our official acceptance for the parade yet.
  - Sunday, kids can choose to stay in Disney or their group and some chaperones can go to Six Flags on Sunday.
  - Everyone will need to provide their own lunch at the airport on Monday on the way back.
  - Chaperones' food will not be covered during the trip.
  - There will not be a school bus from the airport back to Century. Everyone will need to arrange transportation for when we return.
  - There will be a truck for uniforms and instruments to drive them down so that we don't need to take these things on the plane.
  - Students will need to stay with chaperones in the airport. They will need to stay with their group the rest of the time. Minimum of 4 per group.
  - If we keep a trip to Medieval Times on Thursday night and do 6 Flags on the 3rd day, we will need to charge about \$100 more per person for the trip. Or we can keep the cost the way it is and do pizza instead for dinner the first night and skip 6 Flags. A vote was taken and the vote was to keep the itinerary the way it is. More details will be mailed out to those going on the trip asap.
  - A copy of the current itinerary plans are below. It may change slightly between now and the trip.
