

# Disneyland Packing List

Please mark everything with your name tag. Students are allowed 1 carry-on and 1 personal item. Please see chart for airline group assignment. You may carry on one bag, which should be no bigger than the following measurements: **22" x 14" x 9" - these dimensions include the wheels and handles.**

You may also carry on one personal item such as a purse, briefcase, backpack, or laptop computer. Mr. Dunlop recommends that clarinets and flutes be packed into your carry-on or personal item. All other instruments need to be packed into an equipment truck. The equipment truck will load Wed. May 18th at 8:00AM.

## To Bring:

- Medication, if needed (must be checked in after school, between 5:30 and 6:30p.m. on Wed, March 18th ) please look at website for instructions
- 4 day's clothes
  - Shorts, short-sleeved shirts, 1 or 2 pants, a sweatshirt, etc.
- Swimming suit (please think modestly)
- pool towel
- Appropriate group sleepwear
- Marching shoes
- Personal hygiene:
  - Deodorant, towel, shampoo, brush/comb, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.
- Instrument ( packed 5/18 8:00AM)
- Instrumental supplies: reeds, oils, straps, etc.
- Century t-shirt
- Black socks for parade
- Light rain jacket( no rain on forecast)
- 1 stamp (forever stamp)
- \$5.00 in ones to be used as a tip
- Food money kids will be responsible for 2 lunches at the airport going and returning. I will be giving them breakfast and \$20 per day. I would recommend they bring additional money for food (\$40-\$80)
- PHOTO ID!!! Either a driver's license or student ID
- Phone / phone charger/charger
- Empty water bottle

## Can Bring:

- Spending money (or VISA)
- Good Book

## Cannot Bring

- Liquid in a container carrying more than 4 oz

## Alaska Airlines Baggage rules

### Carry-on luggage

When traveling with us, you're allowed one carry-on bag plus one personal item, such as a purse, briefcase or laptop computer. At least one of the items should be stowed under the seat in front of you, and you'll also need to be able to lift your own bag into the overhead bin.

### Carry-on bag size

**The carry-on bag size limit for flights has changed to 22" x 14" x 9" - these dimensions include the wheels and handles. Be sure to measure your bag carefully before you fly.**

You'll still be allowed one carry-on bag and one personal item such as a purse, briefcase, or laptop bag. To help make the boarding process as smooth as possible for everyone, make sure that your items are within the size limits described below, so they'll fit into the overhead bin or under the seat in front of you. Please refer to our [Batteries and Electronics page](#) for information about Smart bags, Self-Propelled bags, eBags, and bags that can charge electronic devices.

### How can I measure my carry-on bag to make sure it fits?

To help you confirm your luggage size, there are bag sizers at airport locations that feature the 22" x 14" x 9" dimensions.

Before you leave for the airport, please measure your bag to make sure that the body of the bag itself, along with the wheels and handles, are 22" x 14" x 9" or less.

All 3 measurements – length + height + width - may not add up to more than 45 inches. If you have a soft-sided or expandable suitcase, you may want to measure your suitcase again once you've packed it, to make sure it still fits within the limit.
