

Century Band Boosters
Board meeting
Feb 8, 2022

- Jazz festival
 - This Saturday at W. Salem HS. We will meet at Century at 11. An email was sent with details. Students should ride the bus there but parents can pick them up and take them home when they are finished if you would like. Please check out with Mr Dunlop before leaving. No food will be sold on site so students should bring their own food for the day. We need a couple of parents who are willing to ride the bus down and back. If you ride the bus you get in free.

- Winter seasons
 - All of the winter groups are doing well. Guard has a showcase this Saturday.
 - Percussion: Percussion might need some uniform help. We will send more information when we are ready for that.
 - Guard: The guard has an upcoming showcase at Glencoe HS this Saturday (2/12). The plan is to meet @Glencoe at 11:30 and be done at 5. More details will come when we have them. We will need help getting the floor from Imlay to Glencoe from someone with a truck.
 - Props: We could use more volunteers to help work on props this Thursday (2/10).

- Disney
 - We have flight info now, flight costs (\$411/person) and hotel info. Mr Dunlop can send info to anyone interested in joining us but isn't signed up as a chaperone. Our audition video was not accepted but they did hold the date for us. We will need to record a new audition tape. There is a date on the calendar (March 4 from 3:30-5). Everyone needs to make sure their payments are up to date. Mr Dunlop will start calling people who are signed up but are behind. This is because we need to start making payments and deposits.

- Cluster concert (3/15)
 - There will be a rehearsal 3/14 for 5th/6th graders. We will need some high school students to come and help with this rehearsal. More info will come later. The concert is scheduled for 3/15. We will be limiting tickets to 4 per performer. Masks and social distancing will be required as of now.

- CHOMP
 - We have tentative approval for CHOMP from the administration at Century. We are just waiting for the last approval that we need from HSD offices. We are scheduled to start March 2. Posters will come out this week. As usual, it will be

on Thursday nights. The concert is on the calendar for May 12. We will need high school students to help. Will need to keep attendance better than we usually do for contact tracing in case that is necessary. We could probably use a parent volunteer who is willing to come and help take attendance for the first couple of weeks. Let Mr Dunlop know if you are interested.

- Rose Parade (6/11)
 - We have gotten the official invitation to join this year's Rose Parade. It is scheduled for the day after graduation. Seniors can choose whether to join us. More info will be available later.

- Fundraising
 - Can drive (2/19). We need more parents to come help! Last month there were not enough and it was difficult to get all of the cans collected.
 - Mod pizza (2/10)
 - Pie sales will take place in March. Delivery is scheduled for 4/14, just in time for Easter.
 - Mother's Day baskets (3/30-4/20) with pickup May 5&6. There will be more variety this year. We will have sun and shade baskets in 2 different sizes.
 - Fun Run: We have been working on planning a fun run fundraiser that will include 5K/10K/family fun run. Mr Dunlop is working with the city of Hillsboro to get a path through S. Hillsboro. They would like to coordinate it with the opening of the new wellness center this spring. More details will be shared as we have them.
 - Auction (5/14). We have a group of 5 parents who are working on gathering donations. If you would like to help, please let Barb know (fundraising@centuryband.org). We are looking for some big items for the live auction. If you know of something that we might be able to auction off or know of a company that would be willing to donate, let us know. Each section will be asked to put together a basket for the silent auction.
 - Officers working on putting together a student-led fundraiser.

- Volunteers

 - Guard equipment. The guard has been organizing flags and uniforms. They could use more volunteers. You can use the link above to sign up to help with that too.
 - Can drives need more parent volunteers. This is one of our biggest fundraisers. We need to have more parents to pick up the cans and bottles that the students collect and bring them back to Century.
 - HSD is requiring all volunteers to complete a fingerprint criminal background check by 3/28. Everyone needs their own access code to sign up for the

background check so if you don't have one, email Kristina Gantt (ganttk@hsd.k12.or.us) to get one. The fingerprinting takes 5 minutes and can be done at the UPS store in Sunset Esplanade.

- When you enter parent volunteer hours in Charms, please remember to put them under the parent's name, not the student's name. Otherwise, our volunteer coordinator will not see them on her report. That is just a quirk of CHARMS and not something that we can change.
