- Jazz festivals: West Salem Jazz Festival
 - **Location-**
 - West Salem High School 1776 Titan Dr. NW, Salem OR., 97304
 - **Cost-**
 - All Participants are free however parents and guest will need to purchase a day pass to enter the performance area. The cost for the general public is \$10, students, seniors and military are \$5, children under 5 are free. I do have room for 5 chaperones. If you ride the bus it is free.
 - **Transportation- We will have a school bus for all participants**
 - **We will leave Century at 11:00**
 - **We will return to Century at 10:30**
 - Students are not allowed to drive themselves or others. We would like to have all the students travel together on the bus to the competition. If you would like to take your student home after they perform please make sure that they check out with Mr. Dunlop. Parents may only take their own student home unless it has been previously arranged and proper forms are filled out.
 - **Food-** As part of the COVID requirements food will not be sold at this event. Please bring your own food.
 - **Performance Times-**
 - Combo 1 : warm-up 2:00 , perform at 2:30 PM
 - Silver Band : warm-up 4:00, perform at 4:30 PM
 - One o'clock Jazz Band -warm-up 6:00, perform at 6:30 PM
 - Awards are at 9:00PM
- Winter seasons
 - Percussion: Kids are working hard.
 - Guard: We need volunteers to help organize flags and uniforms. We will send out a signup for next Thursday. The costume info ready for next week's parent meeting. The cost will be \$125.
 - Winds: Going well. Fair share payment due March 11.

- Props: Prop building will be Thursdays (2/3 and 2/10) 6-8:30. We will send out a request for help. We will be renting trucks to haul props and instruments to competitions.
- Food: We aren't going to provide food for now because of covid restrictions.. Students will provide their own.
- Trailer: The permanent solution to our trailer break-ins is a parking spot near the baseball field. We need to wait for better/drier weather to get that set up.
- Cluster concert is on the calendar for 3/15.
- Disney: Chartering a plane was too expensive so we will be buying regular plane tickets.
- Fundraising
 - Spring Pie sale: Delivery will be 4/14 (Thursday before Easter). Sales mid-March. More details coming soon.
 - Auction: We have 5 parent volunteers who are going to start organizing. Kimberly Moeller volunteered to coordinate the auction. Their first meeting is tomorrow (2/2) at noon. The venue for the auction is secured.
 - Fun Run: Mr Dunlop has been working with Steve Calloway and the new S Hillsboro Wellness Center (Cornelius Pass south of TV Highway). We may line up our run with the opening of the center and set up the end there at the center. There is not a solid date for that yet. The city can help us coordinate road closures but by doing it in S. Hillsboro, there wouldn't need to be many. We are looking to set up a 5K, 10K, and family fun mile. Mr Dunlop has figured out a shipping option that is cheaper if we want to let schools who are further away join us virtually.
 - Mother's Day basket sales also are set up. More details coming soon.
 - Can drive moved to 2/19.
 - Maybe set up a ?-a-thon fundraiser of some sort. Mr Dunlop will talk to the student leadership team and see what they think.
 - Mr Dunlop has been thinking about setting up a can drop off on Thursday nights. 2 students could sign up to collect any that are dropped off for a point. Madeline would like some help picking up cans from people who email cans4bands@centuryband.org. Contact her if you can help.
- Rose parade: We are invited to march in the Rose Parade (6/11).
- We need to re-film the parade audition for Disneyland before March 15.
- Volunteers: We need more help with fundraisers than we have been getting.

- Treasurers: Need to go over the budget and see where we are. They also need to look at who has paid fall fees before we make final Disney arrangements. Percussion uniform costs will be ready to send out in the next week or so.
