- Treasurers:
  - Monica is still catching up on putting payments into CHARMS that were sent over the last few days. The flower basket sale ends tomorrow. The credit info should be in everyone's account early next week. Our hotel payment is due 4/28. Please get your trip payments in so that we have enough to cover it.
  - Camp Yamhill: free w/12 fundraising points, 8-11 points (\$75), 7 points or fewer (\$150). There is a list on the band room door where students can check and an online page where they are tracked.
  - Our counting of points restarts after camp so you can get a head start for next year.
  - The band website will be updated soon to include the rest of the Disney payments.
  
- Camp Yamhill:
  - We will be leaving after 1st period on Friday. We will send out a packing list. If your student has a different allergy or food restrictions than what was put on your travel form in the fall, please let us know asap so that we can update that. We will be back Saturday night. Some 8th graders and Freshmen who haven't marched with us before are joining us for camp. This is the majority of our practice for parades. Everyone planning to join us for parades this spring should be there. We will also do our leadership clinic and votes for section leaders and drum majors for next year there.
  - Prescription medicine needs to be dropped off to the band room on Thursday night in the original bottle with their name on it and only the number of pills that they need for the trip. All medications should be in a zip lock bag with the form available [here](#). If students are self carrying their medication (epi-pens, inhalers, etc), they need [this form](#). HSD requires students be 16+ to self carry their medication.
  - Everything students bring should have their name on it. We will be loading everything onto the truck in the morning before 1st period. Students should bring a sack lunch for Friday. Other food will be provided.
  - We still need some more male chaperones. Let Joy know if you can help us out ([volunteers@centuryband.org](mailto:volunteers@centuryband.org)). You can also join us after work on Friday if necessary.

- Disney updates: Students were asked to pick their roommates for the trip. That is already done. If they didn't choose, then Mr Dunlop chose for them. Chaperones will have 2 per room. We had some donations that were sent to help cover the extra cost that we had to add for some students who couldn't afford it. If you need help, let Mr Dunlop know. Students can switch groups for the 3rd day if they need to for Six Flags/Disney. They do not need to decide with the rest of their group that they are assigned to for the first 2 days. We will be marching in the parade on Saturday. Friday we will get music for a movie and we will perform with the movie. They will make a video of us playing with the movie that we can keep. There is no bus bringing us back from the airport. You will need to pick up your student at the airport or make arrangements to get back from the airport.

  - Mother's Day baskets. The basket sale ends 4/20. We can not accept any orders past the end of the day on 4/20 so get your orders in. Pickup will be May 5&6.
  - It's a Small Word (4/13) The students visited 636 houses. Our goal was at least 400. The students collected \$4006 in donations that night and more has been coming in through the band's website.
  - Auction. Ticket sales are up on the website. Invite your friends and family to come and participate in the auction. We are working on a way to let people view and bid on items remotely. Hopefully we can figure out a way to make that happen. Tickets are \$25 each and include dinner. There will be chicken, beef, and vegetarian options for dinner. If you have dietary restrictions, please email Barb and she will get a number for the chef and he will come up with a solution. Student baskets are due this Thursday (4/21). Tickets will be on sale through the website through 4/30.
